#### In receipt of a Hunting Permit to hunt deer at Six Mile Run Reservoir Site, I have read, understand and agree to:

- Provide valid NJ Hunting License and proof of ID (driver's license, or government issued Non-Driver Card). By completing the application agreement sheet, the applicant agrees to the verification of their status as a licensed hunter of New Jersey. The hunter's license must be in good standing, with no violations, for the past 5 years.
- **Applicants agree to complete and return a Deer Harvest Report by March 30, 2026.** Failure to do so may result in the suspension of hunting privileges within Six Mile Run in future seasons. Hunters must also report all harvests through The New Jersey DEP Fish and Wildlife Automated Harvest Report System and provide **DMZ and DMU information**.
- **Maximum of 1 stands/blinds per registered hunter. Each stand must clearly display owner's Conservation Id Number and ASSIGNED PERMIT NUMBER. Stand's without owner's information displayed may be confiscated.** All tree stands/blinds must be portabl. Use of spikes, nails, screws or any other fastening device that pierces a tree or shrub is expressly prohibited. Stands/blinds may be erect 30 days prior to start of the hunting season and all hunting equipment must be removed 2 weeks at the close of the season. Stands shall not be placed in dead or diseased trees and no vegetation is to be cut or removed from within the Six Mile Run Reservoir Site. Equipment is left at the user's risk.
- Hunters must become familiar with the official trail system within Six Mile Run Reservoir Site and shall not aim in the direction of any trail whenever they are located within **150 feet of the trail**.
- Vehicles are restricted to authorized public roads and designated state park parking areas only. Do not block any road accesses or gates. **Vehicles MUST have parking permit displayed when in Hunter Only lots.**
- **Hunting is NOT permitted on Sundays.** No entrails are to be left on the trails or parking areas.
- Be mindful there are many farm leases within the hunting area. Disturbance or destruction of agricultural crops is prohibited. No stands/blinds are permitted in leased fields and hunters should limited access onto agricultural fields to retrieve game.
- All New Jersey DEP Fish and Wildlife Regulations must be followed. Hunting Regulations can be found at <http://state.nj.us/dep/fgw/njregs.htm>. All NJ State Parks rules and regulations must be followed. Be courteous and aware of other park users.
- **Safety Zone within Six Mile Run is 450 for bow seasons.** Hunters are responsible to know the park boundaries, safety zones and restricted areas. No stands/blinds should be visible from residential buildings.
